SNOW EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 510

At the September 7, 2021, Wind Gap Borough Council enacted an updated Ordinance that establishes regulations governing the operation of and the parking of motor vehicles on streets within the Borough during Snow Emergencies, during snow and ice storms, and during the removal of snow and/or ice from or on Borough streets.

A Snow Emergency shall be declared when a Winter Storm Watch is posted for Northampton County by the National Weather Service for six (6) or more inches of snow or if the actual or expected precipitation of snow or other weather conditions will create a hazardous or dangerous condition on the streets.

Vehicular Use of and Parking on Snow Emergency Routes:

After the declaration of a Snow Emergency, no person shall operate vehicles or any nature without tire chains or snow tires on any Snow Emergency Route.

Within two (2) hours after the declaration of a Snow Emergency, no person shall park or permit to remain parked any vehicle on a Snow Emergency Route.

- East Third Street
- West Center Street
- West West Street
- East West Street
- South Lehigh

PLEASE NOTE: "No person shall throw, shovel, cast or otherwise place, pile, deposit or dump snow removed from sidewalks, walkways, driveways, or any other locations onto any street in the Borough".

Trail to Town Offers Three Different Camper Experiences

Webelos/AOL Camper – Webelos will participate in a schedule of advancement and fun. Webelos will participate in a 5 mile Trail to Town hike and work on Webelos Walkabout, Webelos First Responder, AOL-Outdoor Adventure, and AOL-Scouting Adventure.

Base Camper – Base Campers will develop basic scout skills and participate in a 5 mile Trail to Town hike. Base campers will have the opportunity to develop first-aid, navigation, and nature skills to fulfill rank requirements for tenderfoot, second class and first class. Base Campers first class or higher will volunteer as Youth Instructors for Webelos and Base Campers, teaching basic scout skills.

Backpackers – Backpackers will participate in a backpacking experience, geared for first class scouts and higher. Backpackers prepare breakfast, break down camp, load their packs and board a bus that will transport them to Fox Gap. They will spend the day on the AT hiking from Fox Gap to Wind Gap. The 10 mile Trail to Town hike will return to Wind Gap Park after about 6 hours on the trail.

What Wind Gap Borough Can Recycle

These items may be placed in the container for single-stream recycling

- Plastics: 1,2,3,4,5,6,7
- Glass: bottles and jars
- Metal: bi-metal, aluminum or tin cans
- Paper: newsprint, small cardboard boxes (shoe, gift, cereal boxes), magazines, phone books, envelopes, junk mail
- · Cartons: Milk, cream, wine, juice, broth, egg substitutes
- Corrugated cardboard: please cut or flatten boxes

These items are not accepted for recycling

- Plastics: any plastic that is not marked with 1 to 7 in recycling symbol, toys, garden hoses, pool covers, bowling balls, clam-shell containers (think tomato and fruit containers)
- Glass: mirrors, plate glass, drinking glasses, glass cookware
- · Electronics: TV's, microwave ovens, appliances
- Styrofoam, propane tanks, tires
- Any soiled or greasy paper or cardboard, including pizza boxes
- Used Syringes please use our Think Green from Home program for this

Waste Management will not collect yard waste, grass, televisions, computer equipment, appliances containing refrigerants, construction debris and hazardous waste. Our company also will not collect any liquid waste, including paint. If you have paint you no longer need, attempt to give it to someone who can use it. Otherwise, before placing out for the trash collection allow the paint to dry out or add cat litter or sand to the paint so that is no longer liquid.
