## Police Department Chief Message

**2017** has been another exciting year for the police department. We have continued to experience a continued excellent relationship with our community, continuing our Junior Police Academy and again this year, sponsoring a family this Christmas season. The department also implemented the new D.A.R.E. program at the Wind Gap Middle School, held an eight week long Citizen's Police Academy class and partnered with Recovery Revolution to provide drug and alcohol treatment information to those who are in need.

The past year continued to be a great experience, working alongside the dedicated officers and staff of the department.

The transformation of the department continued this year by the use of several grants. With the continued support from our local officials, the department benefitted from grants from the Pennsylvania Department of Economic and Community Development along with grant funding from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. We put the funding to great use; offsetting the costs for uniforms, furniture, and equipment. The Department continues with the process of accreditation through the Pennsylvania Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission. This process will help insure that departmental policies, procedures and building are compliant to Pennsylvania Accreditation Standards.

I continue to look forward to enhancing the safety of our community, leading the police department and working with community. It is with great pleasure that I have this opportunity to work with the officers, staff and members of the Slate Belt Regional Police Commission.

## Trash Curbside Collection

Your waste will be collected curbside each Friday except after Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, Labor Day, Christmas and New Year's Day when collections will occur on Saturday.

## Recycling Curbside Collection

Recycling collection will occur every other Friday

## Single Stream Recycling Collection

All recyclables may be placed in the same recycling container and put out for collection every other Friday.



## What Wind Gap Borough Can Recycle

### These items may be placed in the container for single-stream recycling:

- Plastics: 1,2,3,4,5,6,7
- Glass: bottles and jars
- Metal: bi-metal, aluminum or tin cans
- Paper: newsprint, small cardboard boxes (shoe, gift, cereal boxes), magazines, phone books, envelopes, junk mail
- Cartons: Milk, cream, wine, juice, broth, egg substitutes
- Corrugated cardboard: please cut or flatten boxes

### These items are **not accepted** for recycling:

- Plastics: any plastic that is not marked with 1 to 7 in recycling symbol, toys, garden hoses, pool covers, bowling balls
- Glass: mirrors, plate glass, drinking glasses, glass cookware
- Electronics: TV's, microwave ovens, appliances
- Styrofoam, propane tanks, tires
- Any soiled or greasy paper or cardboard, including pizza boxes

## Did you know?

Life in Wind Gap Borough is more affordable thanks to an agreement between our community and Waste Management's Grand Central Landfill.

Through the borough's neighboring municipality agreement, the landfill in 2017 provided the borough with \$261,667 in cash payments and provided the borough with free weekly waste collection and disposal service and every-other-week recycling collection.

The waste and recycling collection service is estimated to be worth about \$252,000. The combined value of the monetary and service benefits is \$513,667.

## WIND GAP BOROUGH AND PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP - INTERMUNICIPAL ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICES:

The contiguous municipalities of Plainfield Township and Wind Gap Borough have entered into an Intermunicipal Road Maintenance Services Agreement (dated May 24, 2017) in order to jointly purchase the following asphalt road construction and repair heavy equipment/vehicles:

- Asphalt Paving
- Tack Coat Distributor Machine
- Vibratory Roller
- Air Brake/Air Ramp Trailer

Regular access to the above heavy equipment is essential to enable both municipalities to commence a program to jointly conduct asphalt road base course and wearing course reconstruction/repairs by facilitating the sharing of municipal resources and promoting the principles of intergovernmental collaboration.

Plainfield Township has obtained grant funds in the sum of \$204,069.00 through the Commonwealth Financing Authority via the Local Share Account- Monroe County gaming grant program in order to purchase the asphalt road construction and repair heavy equipment/vehicles. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of July 12, 1972, No. 180, as amended by Act of October 8, 1986, No 137 (53 P.S. §481, et seq.) provides the legal basis for executing a shared use agreement for Public Works/Road equipment personnel. Section 2303 (a) indicates that

“two or more local governments in this Commonwealth may jointly cooperate, or any local government may jointly cooperate with any similar entities located in any other state, in the exercise or in the performance of their respective government functions, powers or responsibilities.”

Plainfield Township Board of Supervisors and Wind Gap Borough Council determined that collaboration between Plainfield Township and Wind Gap Borough in the sharing of equipment, vehicles, machinery and personnel to perform road maintenance and related services would improve efficiency, improve the quality of municipal service delivery and have the potential to save money for both the Township and the Borough. The purpose and objective of the Agreement was to eliminate duplicative municipal services and to increase municipal efficiency, reduce costs and improve the effectiveness of road repair and maintenance operations. As Plainfield Township and Wind Gap Borough are already participants in the Slate Belt Council of Governments, intergovernmental collaboration between any members of the COG is encouraged.

### Local or Regional Economic Development Plan or Strategy:

By receiving grant funding for the majority of costs of the project from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania DCED Local Share Account-Monroe County gaming grant program, the Township/Borough were able to lower the direct capital expenditures of the municipality, thereby increasing the overall cost benefits and savings to both municipalities. As a result of the grant funding, the municipal matching cost of the capital expenditures was \$24,958.00 (split evenly between both municipalities at \$12,479.50).

### Attention Persian Gulf Conflict Veterans

If you served on active duty in the Persian Gulf Theater of Operations, including Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, you may be eligible for the Persian Gulf Conflict Veterans Bonus. The bonus pays \$75 per month for qualifying, active-duty service members, up to \$525 maximum.

For personnel whose death was related to illness or injury received in the line of duty in Operations Desert Shield or Desert Storm, there is an additional \$5,000 available to the surviving family. Service members who were declared prisoners of war may also be eligible for an additional \$5,000.
