ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WIND GAP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 116, PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM THE SIDEWALKS OF THE BOROUGH OF WIND GAP AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO REMOVE SAID SNOW, ICE OR OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Wind Gap, in Council assembled, and it is hereby so ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 116 enacted by the Borough Council of Wind Gap on November 1, 1937 is hereby amended in its entirety.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit snow or ice or any other obstruction to remain upon the public sidewalks within the Borough for a period longer than twenty-four (24) hours.

SECTION III. It shall also be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit any obstruction on public sidewalks or to permit said sidewalks to otherwise fall into an unpassable, unsanitary or unsafe condition. The duties of this Ordinance shall be upon the person, firm or corporation occupying or using the property along or in front of which the public sidewalk lays, and in the case of property which is unoccupied or vacant, the duty shall be upon the owner or owners thereof.

SECTION IV. Any person, firm or corporation violating this

Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each day snow, ice or obstructions are permitted to remain on the public sidewalk. In addition, any person or persons violating the Ordinance shall be compelled to pay the cost of removing the ice, snow or other obstruction together with an additional penalty of ten (10%) percent of said cost, or, in default of a payment of such fine and cost, shall be guilty of a summary offense to be prosecuted before the local District Justice.

SECTION V. Any Ordinance or any part of any Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed. In the event that any part of this Ordinance is deemed to be unenforceable the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall still be construed as being in full force and effect.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall be placed into immediate effect upon enactment hereof.
