

BOROUGH OF WIND GAP

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRANSPORTATION OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS FROM PLACE TO PLACE WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WIND GAP OR FROM PLACES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WIND GAP TO POINTS BEYOND THE LIMITS THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION THEREOF, BY THE MAYOR OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WIND GAP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, THAT:

SECTION 1. No person or persons, firm, or corporation, shall move, or cause to be moved, from any place within the Borough of Wind Gap to another place therein, or place beyond the limits thereof, any household goods in bulk, without first securing from the Mayor or Chief of Police of the Borough of Wind Gap a permit for such moving transportation.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons, firm, or corporation desiring such a permit for the removal or transportation of household goods in the manner above-described, shall make application to the Mayor or Chief of Police of the Borough of Wind Gap setting forth the names of the owners or reputed owners of the property to be moved, the address and location from which the property is to be removed, and the new address or location of the place to which the property is to be removed.

SECTION 3. The Mayor or Chief of Police of the Borough of Wind Gap shall upon application being made as provided for in Section 2 of this Ordinance, issue a permit for which a charge of One (\$1.00) Dollar will be made, setting forth the name of the permittee as well as the name or names of the owners of the goods to be moved and the address from which the goods are to be moved and the address to which the goods are to be delivered.

SECTION 4. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance, or furnishing false information to the Mayor or Chief of Police of the Borough of Wind Gap, or using false names or addresses, shall upon conviction thereof before the Chief Burgess, Justice of the Peace of the Borough, or the District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or to undergo imprisonment not exceeding ten (10) days, or both.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective on October 1, 1971, after due advertisement in accordance with law, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, be, and the same are, hereby repealed.
