The Special Council meeting of the Borough of Wind Gap on Thursday, October 13, 2005, was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Council Vice President George Hinton, at which time he reminded those present that the meeting was being recorded. In attendance were Councilpersons: Winton Male, Jr., Karen Skorochood, Mitchell D. Mogilski, Sr., Tony Curcio. Also in attendance were Mayor Kenneth George, Borough Solicitor Ronold Karasek, Special Solicitor, Karl Longenbach and Secretary/Treasurer Louise Firestone. Absent were Councilmen Kerry Gassler and Scott Parsons.

George Hinton explained that the sole purpose of this Special Meeting was to have Mayor Kenneth George cast the deciding vote.

Secretary Louise Firestone read the following motion made at the Council meeting of October 3, 2005:

**On motion** by Mitchell D. Mogilski, Sr. to move the balance of the County Bond money from the east side of North Broadway to the west side to be used to build a road to connect to Route 33, but knowing that the Borough will not lose the money under any circumstances, if the County is unwilling to move the money, the money will remain for future industrial development as originally intended and seconded by Karen Skorochood. Roll call vote taken. Opposed: T. Curcio, K. Gassler, S. Parsons. In favor: G. Hinton, M. Mogilski, Sr., Karen Skorochood. The vote of the motion was a 3 to 3 tie.

Mayor George voted in favor. Motion carried with a vote of 4-3.

**On motion** by Winton Male to adjourn the meeting of October 13, 2005 and seconded by Tony Curcio. The meeting of October 13, 2005 adjourned at 7:32 p.m.
