# I. Opening/Pledge

# V. Zoning Change

A. A proposed zoning district change from a Medium Density Residential District to Community Commercial District and/or Industrial and Heavy Commercial District on North Broadway. Kerry Gassler spoke on behalf of the Borough and in concurrence to a zoning change of I-C from the American Candle Bldg up to the post at Industrial Road and across to the Ambulance property. Mr. Gassler stated that this zoning change will help the Borough in the future when the Borough decides to sell it's buildings, to include the Ambulance building.

On a motion by Richard Getz, and Seconded by Scott Parsons the Planning Commission recommends that the American Legion Property be re-zoned a Community Commercial District, and the Borough Oaten Garage/Ambulance Property be re-zoned an Industrial and Heavy Commercial District (I-C). Vote 4-0 in favor.
